## **ELECTION PROCEDURE - FOR YOUR IMMEDIATE ATTENTION**

Thank you for your assistance, in assuring that our patients have an opportunity to exercise their voting privilege during their stay at Santa Barbara, Goleta, Santa Ynez Valley Cottage Hospitals and Cottage Rehabilitation Hospital.

- 1. If patients are eligible and would like to vote please provide them with the attached selfexplanatory letter and request/affidavit for emergency absentee ballot.
- 2. Please collect and keep all requests at the nursing station until the morning of Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Please mark all requests with patient room number in upper right corner.
- 3. Between 8:00 AM and 9:30 AM election day (November 3, 2020) a volunteer will pick up all completed requests from the nursing stations.
- 4. On the Election Day, no later than 10:00 AM the requests will be taken to the Santa Barbara County Elections office to be verified as eligible. A designated volunteer will bring the Absentee Ballots to the hospital for distribution.
- 5. The completed Absentee Ballots will be collected from the patients' rooms between 3:30 4:30 PM and returned to the County Elections office.

## Process for the Patient care unit and COVID units.

- 1. Nursing manager will work with the charge nurse to identify who wants to vote. Provide each patient with the form and/or help the patient fill out the form.
  - a. Place form on newly cleaned clipboard
  - b. Have patient perform hand hygiene if possible. Fill out form.
  - c. Wipe off clipboard with disinfectant
  - d. Give completed forms to the volunteers to take to the County Elections office
- 2. Bring ballot for each patient and give to their respective nurse
  - a. Use the same sequence as above
  - b. Unit manager will give the ballots to the volunteer
  - c. Volunteer will collect ballots and take to the polling station
