

## FACT SHEET: Launch Ready Grant

# California Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure Program [www.buildingcalhhs.com](http://www.buildingcalhhs.com)

In 2021, the Department of Health Care Services was authorized to award \$2.1 billion in competitive grants to expand California's behavioral health infrastructure. The Launch Ready grant opportunity, totaling **\$518.5 million**, was released on January 31, 2022, as one of six infrastructure grant rounds. **Applications are due March 31.**

## Who can apply?

Counties, cities, tribal entities, **nonprofit organizations, for-profit organizations, and other private organizations**, including private real estate developers. Each entity can apply independently, jointly, with multiple partners, include multiple counties, and/or take a regional approach.

## What can be funded?

The costs to acquire, construct, and rehabilitate real estate assets to expand the following behavioral health settings that serve youth and/or adult Medi-Cal beneficiaries:

- General acute care hospitals
- Acute care hospitals
- Acute inpatient hospitals—medical detoxification/withdrawal management
- Acute psychiatric inpatient facilities
- Hospital-based outpatient treatment (outpatient detoxification/withdrawal management)
- Intensive outpatient treatment
- Crisis stabilization units
- Sobering centers
- Psychiatric health facilities
- Chemical dependency recovery hospitals
- Narcotic Treatment Programs
- Office-based outpatient treatment
- Mental health rehabilitation centers
- Adolescent residential treatment facilities for substance use disorders
- Adult residential treatment facilities for substance use disorders
- Children's crisis residential programs
- Community treatment facilities
- Short-term residential therapeutic programs
- Skilled nursing facilities with special treatment programs
- Social rehabilitation facilities
- Peer respite
- Community wellness centers
- Recovery residences/sober living homes
