

Qualifying Period	July 30, 2022 - October 28, 2022					
Date of Record	November 28, 2022					
Payment Amounts	Full-time eligible employee up to \$1,000, plus matching up to \$1,500 Part-time eligible employee up to \$750, plus matching up to \$1,250 Eligible Physician up to \$1,000 (excludes Managers/Supervisors, includes Covered Services employees)					
Registration Period	October 21, 2022 – December 21, 2022					
Application Period	November 29, 2022 – December 30, 2022					
Estimated Payment Dates	January 2023 via Covered Entities/Covered Services Employers/Physician Group Entities

- Workers/employees who are eligible to receive a retention payment must have their employers register on their behalf! DHCS encourages eligible workers to reach out to their HR department and work with their employers to support the application process.
- Taking the time to submit an application on behalf of your eligible workforce shows appreciation to the dedicated workers during the COVID-19 pandemic and beyond.
- DHCS is posting successfully registered entities and physicians on the WRP webpage weekly.
- We encourage those that contract with Covered Services Employers
 (CSEs) to reach out and remind them to register on behalf of their workers
 today!

Applying on Behalf of Eligible Workers/Employees (cont.)



Applying on behalf of your eligible workers only takes a few steps.

Register with DHCS first! Qualified Facilities/Covered Entities (CEs), Physician Group Entities (PGEs), Independent Physicians and Covered Services Employers (CSEs) must register with DHCS. Registration takes about 15 minutes to complete.

Apply for payments on behalf of your <u>direct</u> employed eligible work staff. Approximately 10 questions and upload the PDF template with the data elements listed below – that's all!

Required application data

- Eligible worker name
- Last 4-digits of the SSN/ITIN
- Date of birth
- Worker mailing address

Required for Physicians

- NPI
- Medical License number

Required for Non-Physicians

- Time Base (full or part time)
- Hours worked
- Paid bonus information (if applicable)₁₂

Key Dates and Application Steps to Payment



- 1 Register your entity with DHCS.
 - Registration closes December 21, 2022
- 2 Apply on behalf of your eligible workers/employees.
 - LIVE opened November 29, 2022
- 3 DHCS will disperse payments to approved entities/employers to distribute to their eligible workers in January 2023.
