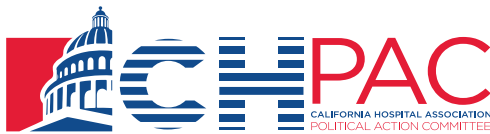
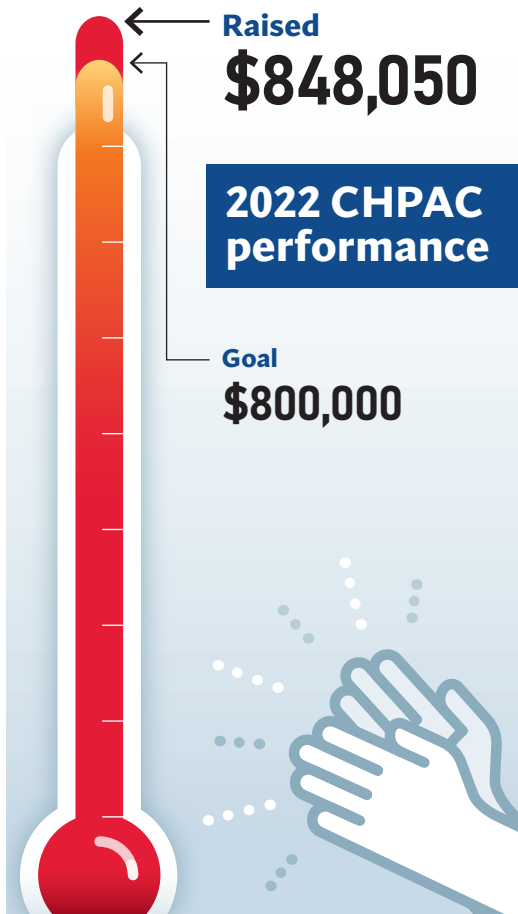


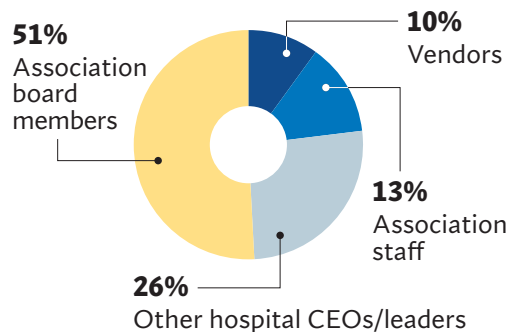
2022 CHPAC Annual Report

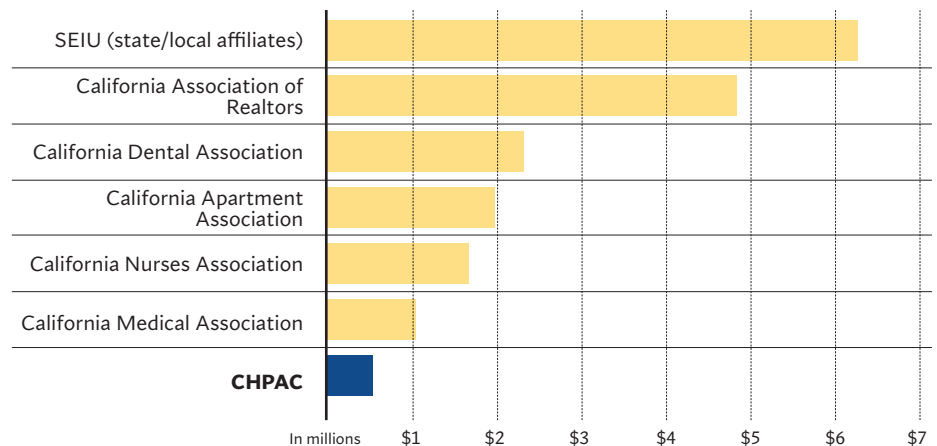
