

Active Shooter Emergency Response Patient Role & Action

Actor 3: _____

Clothing: Work place pants and collared shirt. Medical Center ID.
Additional exercise ID tag says ACTOR

Description: male employee from Decision Support on unit to see Nurse manager for appointment to discuss budget.

Actor: Goes to Nurses Station asks to see Nurse manager – says he has appointment to discuss budget. Greets other employees normally.

Hears commotion and gunshots. Doesn't know unit layout. Not sure what to. Hesitant. Looks up and down hallway. Stops, starts and flatten self against wall. Comes face to face with shooter. Put up hands – say: “Buddy, Buddy - Got no problem with you – I just work here. I'm sure it going be ok. Don't shoot man – I have little kids. I just work here. I have no beef with you.”

Grovels and pleads, “ Don't shoot - don't shoot”. Shooter plays with him a bit and passes by. Does NOT shoot on first encounter.

Actor stays in the hall – continue to look stunned and indecisive, slumps to floor, crawls a bit. Stops. Sits against wall. Shooter comes back and shoots Actor. Actor dies.

Actor: Employee, frightened, pleading, indecisive on action, and dies.

Site: SCVC 3rd floor, Unit B floor

Method: Act in each rotation. Repeat same acting in each side of hall in each of three sessions (total scene repeated 6 times).

Date/time: Tuesday, March 1, 2011 - during exercise play

Role: Patient (Actor)
“THIS IS AN EXERCISE”

DESIRED RESPONSE/ACTUAL RESPONSE: Desired: lends to realization of play
