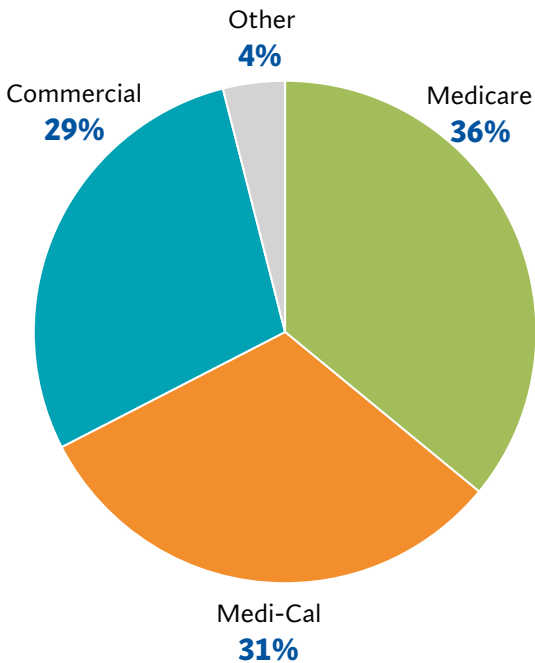

Improving Overall Health

In District 7, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Funding to help women escaping a violent environment access case management, and advocacy for survivors of domestic violence
- Assistance with navigation and coordination of services for victims and survivors of human trafficking
- Significant financial support for the Sacramento Food Bank and Family Services

In 2024, voters in District 7 voted 73% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
