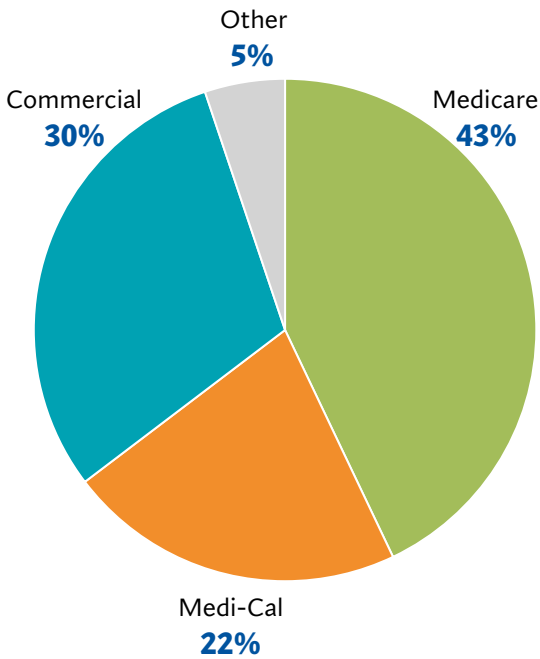

Improving Overall Health

In District 14, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Funding to reduce mental health stigma and increase help-seeking behavior among youth
- Promoting financial health through job training, financial education, and connection to food security programs
- Partnering with organizations that provide services to people experiencing or exiting homelessness

In 2024, voters in District 14 voted 73% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
