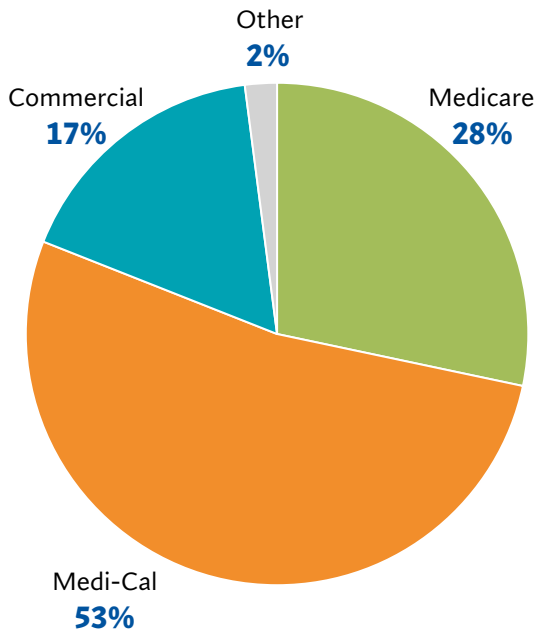

## Improving Overall Health

In District 15, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Funding to help improve the health of elderly relative caregivers raising trauma-exposed children who are unable to stay with their parents
- Funding for nutrition classes and vouchers for fresh produce for low-income individuals at risk of diet-related disease
- Financial support for a nonprofit that provides medical and dental care to uninsured residents in San Mateo County

In 2024, voters in District 15 voted 74% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
