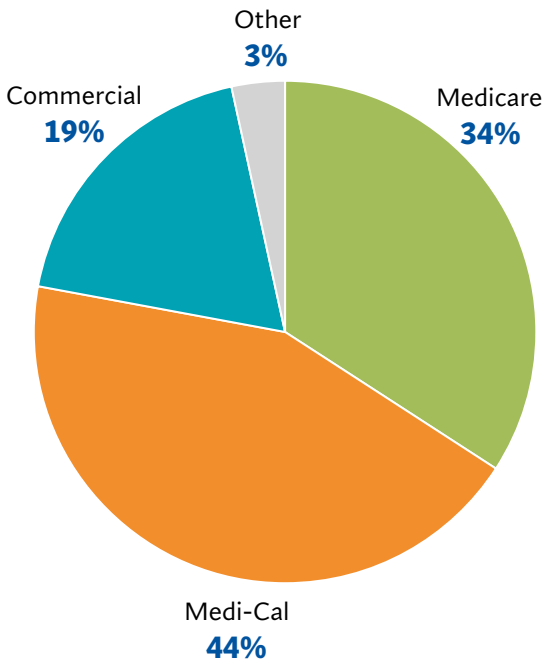

Improving Overall Health

In District 18, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Coordination of clinic education efforts for rural community literacy on the benefits and safety of broad vaccination to combat vaccine hesitancy
- Running a violence intervention program to assist families who have experienced a recent traumatic event such as a shooting, stabbing, or physical violence
- Supporting Blue Zones Project Monterey, which works to reduce chronic illness and improve quality of life

In 2024, voters in District 18 voted 74% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
