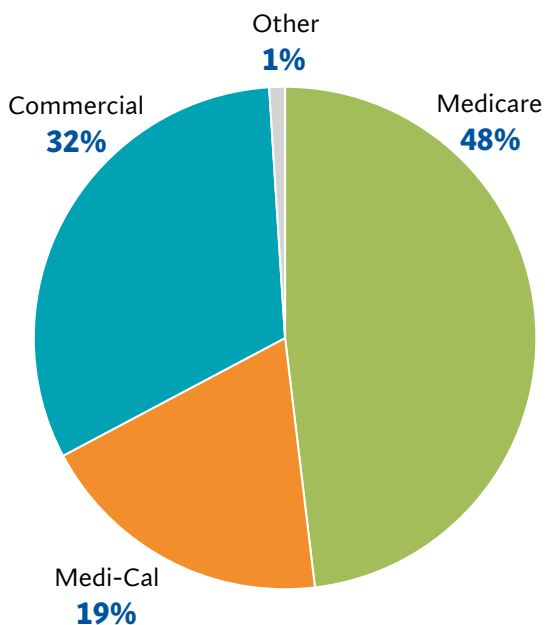

Improving Overall Health

In District 19, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Funding for a City of San José program that provides classes and events to improve the long-term health of older adults
- Funding that supports decreasing food insecurity among local community college students
- Financial support for a program that helps school-aged children receive psychotherapy and mental health services

In 2024, voters in District 19 voted 71% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
