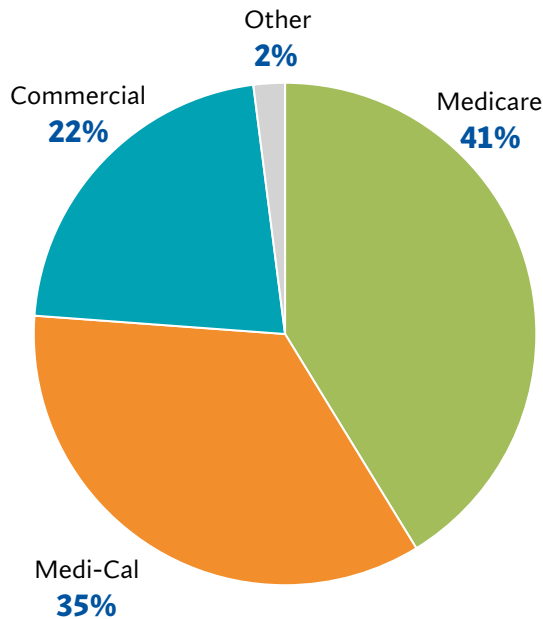

Improving Overall Health

In District 20, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Learning and Outreach Centers that provide referral services, food, clothing, shelter, education, and after school tutoring services to the most vulnerable and needy residents of the community
- Free community-based infant car seat safety checks and replacements for those who cannot afford them
- Health career scholarships

In 2024, voters in District 20 voted 63% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
