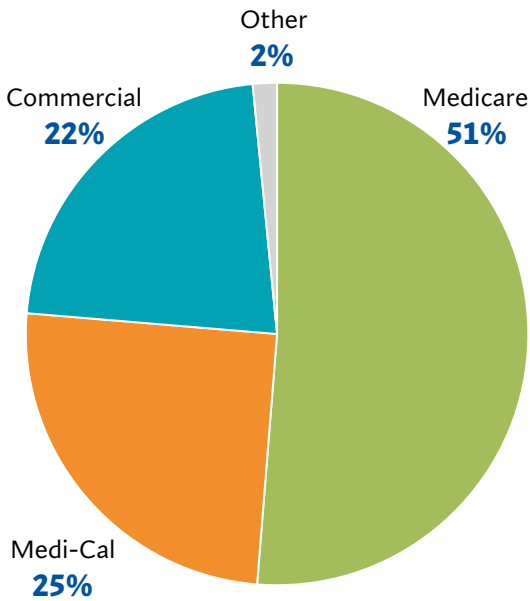

Improving Overall Health

In District 26, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Partnerships to offer a community food pantry that helps community members who are struggling to meet their basic needs
- Recuperative care support for people experiencing homelessness
- Increasing access to adequate nutrition for medically complex populations

In 2024, voters in District 26 voted 66% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
