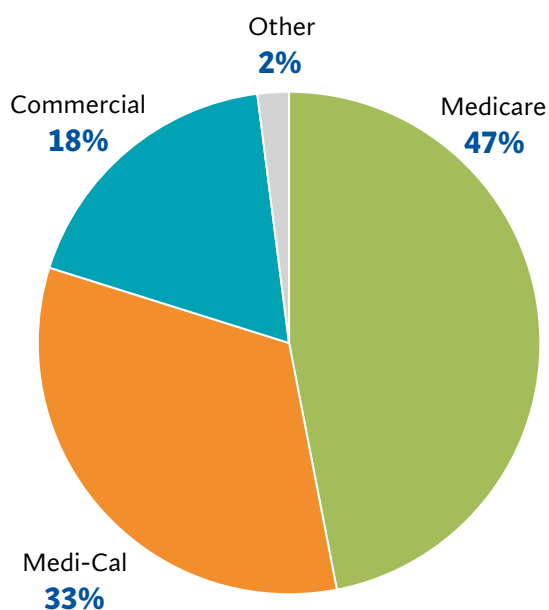

Improving Overall Health

In District 41, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- Partnering with and supporting organizations such as the American Cancer Society, Boys & Girls Club Southwest County, Children's Hospital of Orange County, Support Sisterz Combat Cancer Walk, Trauma Intervention Program, and more
- Financial support for a street medicine program for people experiencing homelessness
- Nursing scholarships for local students

In 2024, voters in District 41 voted 64% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
