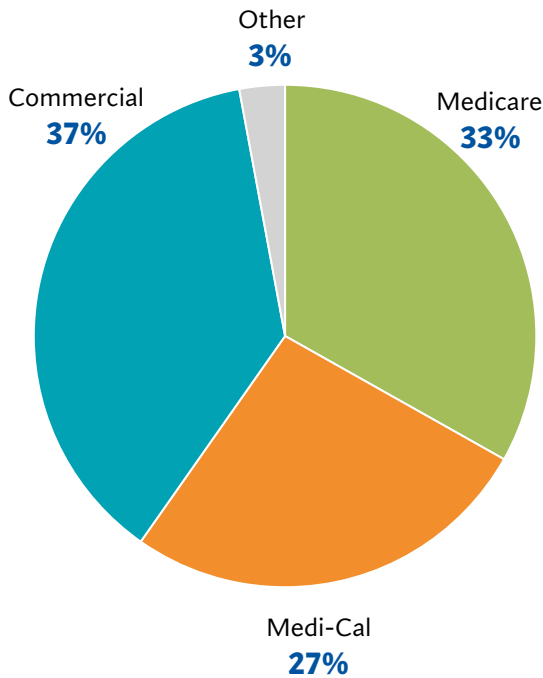

Improving Overall Health

In District 51, some examples of how hospitals meet individual and community health needs include:

- A diaper distribution program to help families facing economic hardship
- Care teams to ensure a safe transition home and ongoing well-being for vulnerable patients
- Funding for no-cost capacity building and workforce development series to transform and adapt nonprofit staff and managers leadership skills

In 2024, voters in District 51 voted 69% in favor of improving funding for Medicaid.
