



Designated and Approved Facilities	Other Entities
<p>Pursuant to Welfare and Institutions (W&I) Code section 5008, “Designated facility,” “facility designated by the county for evaluation and treatment,” or “facility designated by the county to provide intensive treatment” means a facility that meets designation requirements duly established by the State Department of Health Care Services in accordance with Section 5404.</p>	<p>For the purposes of W&I Code Section 5402, any “other entity involved in implementing Section 5150” means any facility, entity, or person not included as a designated facility that is involved in implementing W&I Code Section 5150. Other entities involved in implementing W&I Code Section 5150 include, but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Peace officers, as defined by Chapter 4.5 (commencing with Section 830) of Title 3 of Part 2 of the Penal Code.• Professional persons designated by a county behavioral health director pursuant to W&I Code Section 5121 to perform functions under section 5150, including, but not limited to, members of mobile crisis teams.• Hospital emergency rooms/departments. <p>**“Other Entities” are not approved to offer evaluation and treatment services.</p>

Phase I

Phase II

Implemented the collection of the following data:

- Sequence of holds
- Number of county contracted beds
- SB 43 conditions

Number of county contracted beds


Sequence of holds including persons detained for grave disability due to severe SUD or co-occurring

Phase III

Expanded data-collection elements to include services provided and data from the Judicial Council.

During this phase, DHCS began to prepare the annual report of 2023 data for publication in 2025.

DHCS conducted outreach to reporting entities to obtain missing data and resolve data questions to improve the accuracy of the data collected.



Phase IV

LPS designated and Approved Facilities and Other Entities were instructed to report the total number of persons either detained and/or admitted involuntarily according to the categories below:

- Discharged to a higher level of care
- Discharged to a lower level of care
- Converted from involuntary to voluntary status
- Subsequently incarcerated
