

Hospital Layoffs by Year



- The **more than 3,300 projected** hospital layoffs in 2025 would be the highest total since 2021, and a **48% increase** above the average for the previous 5 years
- Layoffs in 2025 often occurred at vulnerable hospitals caring for underserved populations, including rural hospitals (including one critical access hospital), 2 children's hospitals, hospitals with negative operating margins, and hospitals serving a high proportion of patients with Medi-Cal
